#### SUPPLY LIST & INFORMATION PACKET

#### AIR TRAVEL

Students are responsible for purchasing and arranging their own air travel. Regardless of schedules, all students must arrive at Rome (FCO) Airport no later than 12:00 noon, Monday, September 1, 2008 for Kalwick/Lee Workshops and no later than 12:00 noon, Monday, September 15, 2008 for Liliedahl/George Workshops.

Ground transportation will deliver all students back to the Rome Airport for departure on the last day of each workshop. We will send more detailed information on planning your return flight with your Information Package.

#### REFUND POLICY
